Curriculum	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Signpost parents to curriculum info on website on a regular basis● Ensure all children take home curriculum newsletters (names on them and send via Teachers2Parents)
Communication	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Year 3 and Year 4 to share fortnightly Year group newsletters.● Establish and embed office systems that ensure timely and streamlined information on forthcoming events.● Explain during New to Nursery and New to Reception meetings that the revised Early Year Profile specifically wants staff actively engaging in the children's learning rather than watching and taking photographs that can subsequently be shared.
School Site Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Update the one-way system on the school yard to allow parents and children to leave via the Nursery gates and reduce the bottleneck by the year 4 gate.
