Information from Catering Services—From September 2018 the price of the set 2 course school lunch is being increased from £2.15 to £2.20 per day. School meals continue to be free for all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 as part of the on-going commitment to Universal Infant Free School Meals.



Year 2 Reminder for School Meals - A reminder for parents of children currently in Year 2 that from September 2018 when your children move in to Year 3 they are no longer eligible for Universal Free School Meals which are only available for all children in Reception, Year 1 and 2. All Year 3 parents will need to set up a school meal payment account at www.joinos.com to enable them to pay online. Parents are reminded that catering services do not accept cash payments.
