

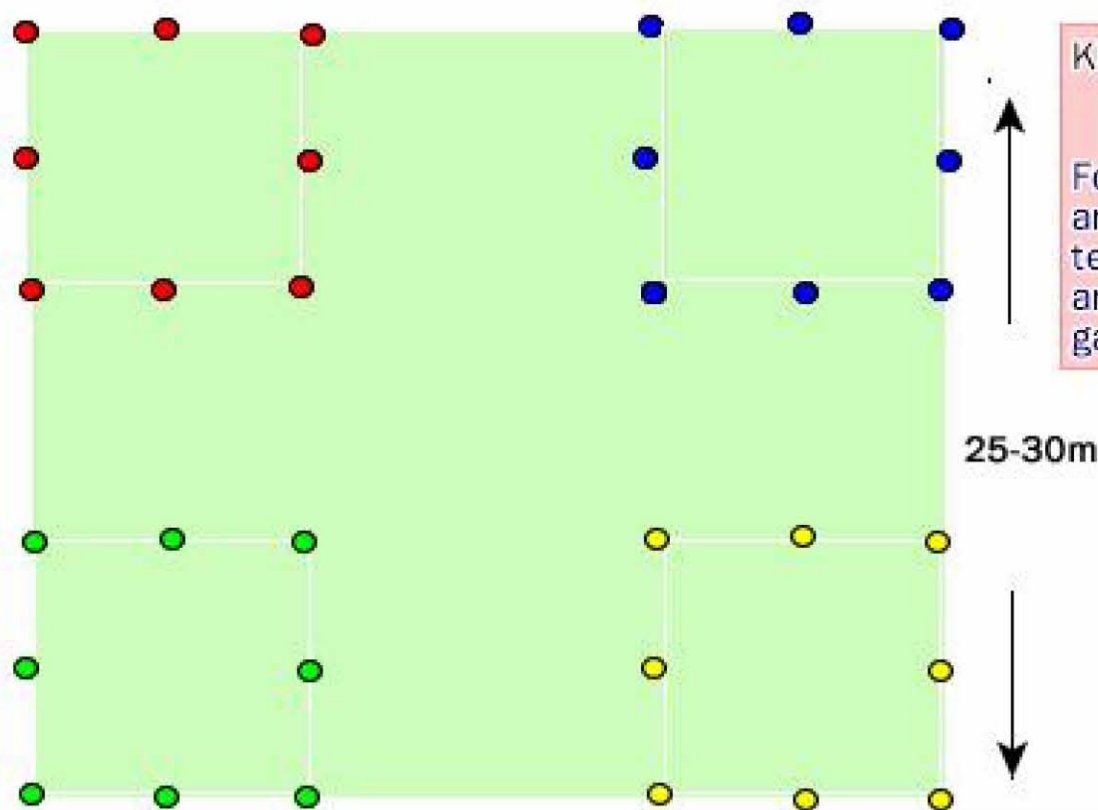
# TEACHING FOOTBALL IN SCHOOLS KEY STAGE 1 Year 2

**PITCH LAYOUT** - For a class of 24 to 30 pupils the playing area is 30 x 30m area divided into smaller units using coloured markers. Lessons can take place on grass, playground or games hall.

## INTRODUCTION:

- All the practical activities are based on the same size layout which can be modified to suit different groupings of children.
- The initial set up has 4 coloured corners as illustrated in the diagram . With very large classes you may need to set up 2 playing areas next to each other.

The core of each lesson are simplified football related games which will make up the major part of the teaching time.
