
We did a worm dance for STEM week and found lots of worms to observe and investigate and this sparked our interest into noticing what is around us.

We have been on a spring hunt and spotted lots of signs of spring around school and in the forest. We spotted the blossom and buds starting to grow on the trees and continued to observe how they have grown and come out in full display over the weeks.

We then went bug hunting to see what bugs and insects are starting to come out now it is springtime. We were amazed at all the bugs and insects we found. From ladybirds to spiders, woodlouse to centipedes. We were very gentle with them and made sure we put them back in their homes once we had looked at them.

Last week was a very exciting week when we found a giant egg in the forest! We built a nest to keep it safe and warm while we waited for it to hatch. This week, we talked about what animals lay eggs and the type of nests they make for their eggs. We then saw a real bird fly into its own nest, and we talked about how that bird may have already laid her eggs now too, so we are going to continue to observe and listen out for signs of baby birds hatching.
