<u>Science</u>

Our Science topic for this half term is Plants and we have set up an Investigation in our classrooms to find out how plants grow in different conditions. Over the coming weeks, we will monitor the growth of the plants and compare them to each other to see how varying amounts of sunlight, water and warmth affect their growth.

<u>Maths</u>

This week, we have been making links to our Geography topic by thinking about how meteorologists measure the weather. We learnt how to read scales counting in steps of 2s, 5s and 10s on thermometers and enjoyed taking our learning outside for a scavenger hunt.







Back in class, we use maps to discover the average temperatures in different countries around the world.
