Having problems on an iPad? Go to your browser's settings and make sure 'Reque Desktop Mode' has not been selected.



Maths

In maths we have been working with decimals and converting units of measure like grams to kilograms or millilitres to litres which is an essential skill in maths. Understanding that dividing by 10 moves the decimal point one place to the left can simplify these conversions. For example, 1000 grams divided by 10 equals 100 grams, and 1000 millilitres divided by 10 equals 100 millilitres. This concept is foundational when moving between units such as grams (g) and kilograms (kg), or millilitres (ml) and litres (l). To make learning these concepts more engaging, try the



interactive decimals game available on Topmarks. This game offers a fun way to practice decimal skills.

History

This half term, the children have been learning all about local boats as part of their local history topic.
