

In English, we have been reading the story Cave Baby, which the children have thoroughly enjoyed. They were especially engaged by the rhythm and rhyme of the text and loved listening to the imaginative adventure of the little cave artist. As part of our learning, we have also been revising key word classes such as nouns, adjectives, and verbs. To support this, the children have been on a fun 'noun hunt' around the school grounds and played lively games of verb charades to help deepen their understanding. They have worked brilliantly to identify word types in the story and are growing in confidence when using them in their own writing.


