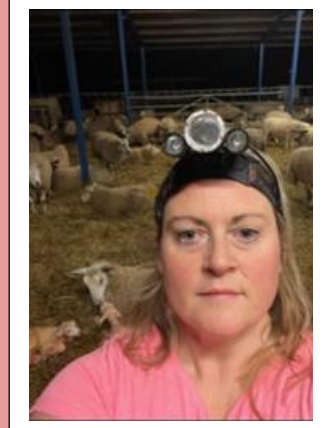
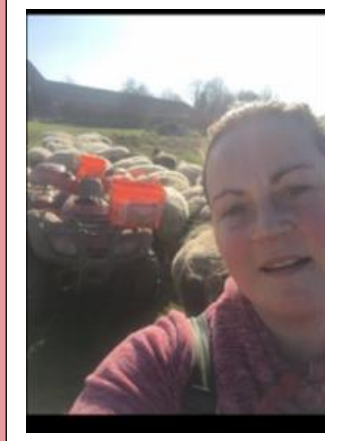


## Nursery Newsletter: 7.11.25



### Farmer Time - Autumn Term

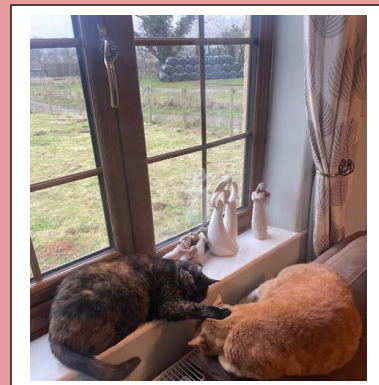

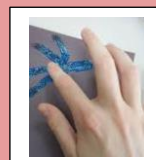
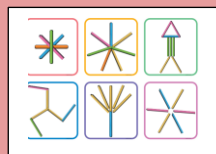

We loved it and can't wait for our next meeting with her.

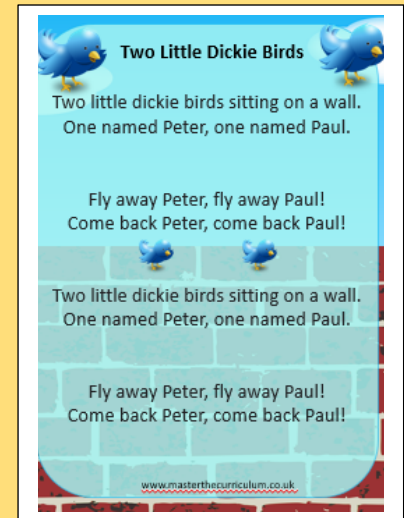
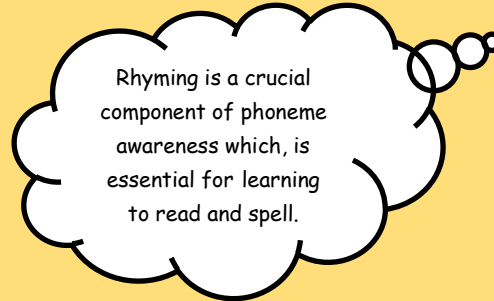

We used their enthusiasm as a springboard for creative activities, including firework-inspired art both on paper and in the glittery sand, through lolly sticks and finger painting.



We've also continued to develop our work on the number 2, exploring it through counting games, songs, and practical activities. The children have put their learning to good use when understanding how many children are allowed in our quiet space-inspired reading and sensory tent. This has helped reinforce turn-taking, number recognition, and independence in a meaningful, everyday context.
