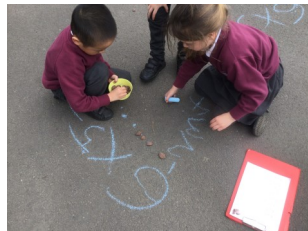
Spelling
