

To make your Egyptian necklace

You will need:

- Either pasta tubes or art straws
- String or wool
- Large needle
- Paint

To begin with, cut a length of thin string or wool. Make sure it will go over your head and add some extra so that you will be able to tie the ends together.

If you are using art straws, cut them into shorter lengths to make the beads.

Now, paint the art straws or pasta. Turquoise was popular as shown in the picture. You may wish to look at other pictures of artifacts and paintings to see what other colours were used.

Thread the wool or string through a large needle.

After the beads have dried, carefully thread enough pasta onto the wool to fill its length, remembering to leave some free wool at the ends for tying.

Tie the ends to complete the necklace.
