



Southridge First School Nursery Newsletter 11th June 2021

The children were so excited to share their holiday news with us and it was just gorgeous to hear about the experiences they have finally had which have been put on hold for so long.

We have talked about the seasons this week and compared winter and summer. We shared our experience of summer and thought carefully about all the things we would pack to take on a trip to the beach.

We read The Black Rabbit by Philippa Leathers this week. A very sweet story about a little rabbit with a big problem. It didn't take our clever Nursery children long to figure out what was following the little white rabbit! This led to some lovely scientific discussion about shadows followed by lots of exciting investigation outside.





In phonics we have been learning about the phoneme /r/ and the sound it makes in words like rainbow, ruler, rabbit and ribbon. It is a long, stretchy sound. We use the picture to help us remember this sound and the formation rhyme to help us write it: down the robot's back and curl over his arm.
