Occasionally there are mix ups with club lists / confusion over whether they have started/ children changing their minds about taking part. **Please be understanding** if the office staff have to contact you or of they need to help teaching staff to clarify names on lists. This can sometimes take time at the end of the day when the office is very busy - they always look after children whilst issues are resolved and do their very best to help parents, staff, outside coaches etc. Our office staff co-ordinate over a thousand places every term for after school clubs and do a fabulous job to ensure that the children have access to a wide range of after school activities.

Governor update - Every term the governors review our data looking at the high standards of attainment achieved last year and performance tables which can be found on our school website. They will also be working with staff to deliver priorities for this academic year - your responses from the parent questionnaire last year and reply slips from annual reports have informed this.

Last half-term governors visited school to observe phonics and Talk4Writing in Early Years and Key Stage 1. They also visited Year 2 classrooms to see the older children developing their mental maths strategies and improving their multiplication skills on 'Rock Star Maths'
