Suggestions: (number in brackets)

More notice for school events such as assemblies to enable parents to take time off work. (1) We always send out our term dates (inc. assemblies) at the start of term, add them to the calendar on the website, to give plenty of advance notice and help working parents. Reminder are included in regular newsletters. From September we will also send text reminders every half-term to remind parents to check the calendar on the website.

It would be great to see more drawing, painting or other artwork available and also gardening for general wellbeing (1)

Mr Wilcock has started a gardening club and this year we will be holding our art exhibition again in the Spring term.

We have simplified our after-school club timetable for the Autumn term due to the coronavirus pandemic but will review these suggestions for the Spring term.

All children are given time for free writing in their Literacy lessons but also have specific writing genres to cover to meet objectives in the English curriculum via taught sessions.

Each class has a class library section and books are regularly updated via the Schools Library Service. Southridge would like an extension to our school to replace the Year 4 mobile classrooms and would request that a dedicated Library space was included in these expansion plans.
