Playing with numbers

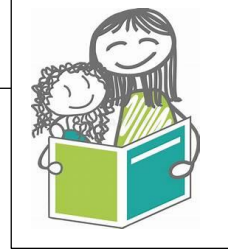
We have noticed that lots of the children are recognising the numbers on dotty dice without needing to count the dots. This indicates that they are using the skill of subitising - the ability to look at a group of objects and immediately know how many there are without counting. On a die, the children will likely be seeing patterns and shapes and recognising them as numbers. Try playing a dice game, to see which dotty numbers your child knows. There are lots of interactive dice games on the internet too.



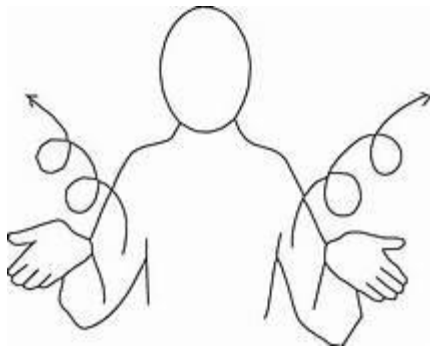
Nursery Library Books
