Some children will:

- Be still working on speed sounds and recognising them. (We gave you a speed sounds chart to help practise them at home)
- Be able to begin blending words with 3 letters together with your help in line with the reading presentation of the correct bounding and stretching sounds.
- Be able to practise the sounds needed to read a simple sentence and recognise tricky words within it by site. In addition they will be able to hold a sentence and repeat it back to you. (For challenge you may wish to ask them to write that sentence down using sound talk to sound out the green words and use capital letters and full stops at the end).

We have been up to the hall to do P.E. We have begun getting our trainers on independently to begin.


We have been practising our coordination during movement and learning how to avoid obstacles, people and move backwards and side wards safely.
