Children will learn about the colour wheel and how we can use colour to produce different effects. They will name, mix, sort and explore colours in art work.

Programming direction

Children will explore 'beebots' – small robots which can be programmed to follow a set of instructions and move in desired directions. They will create algorithms to direct the beebot around a map of Pirate Island.

We will also continue to develop our familiarity and confidence with the different functions of a keyboard and the programmes available on the network. We will be using a range of software to word process, count, draw and gather information.
