The children loved their visit from YogaBugs on Thursday. We listened to the story of the Three Little Pigs and had fun joining in with the story telling yoga moves.

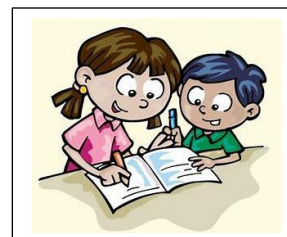


Easter Pattern Pitta Pizza:
