

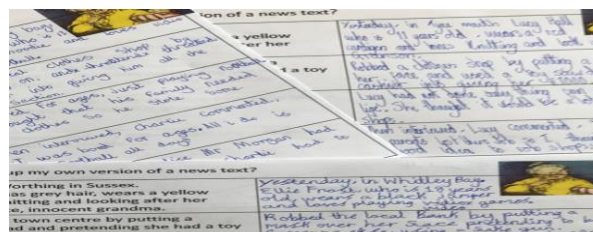


# Year 4 Newsletter

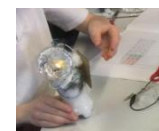


