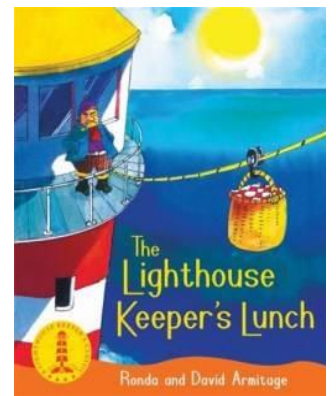
#### YogaBugs:
