

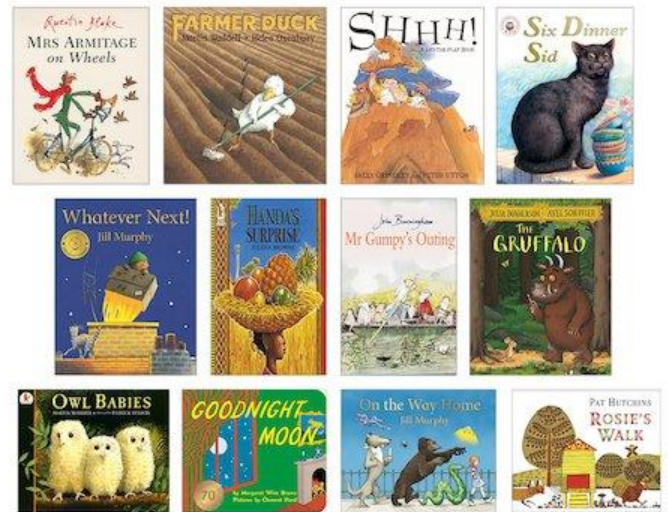
Reception Newsletter: 6.3.20



This week on the build up to World Book Day we have focused on our 'over and over' stories.

We have:

- Labelled 'The Gruffalo'.
- We have filled a basket with our own favourite fruits for 'Handa's Surprise'. (Giving us the opportunity to sound talk our words to fit in a sentence).
- We have used our knowledge of stories and our feelings board to write in the speech bubbles for 'Owl Babies' about how they are feeling. (This links to our emotional literacy).



In maths we have been 'subtracting', taking away and finding less than a given number.

It's important that children can apply their skills across a range of different situations and also develop their mathematical vocabulary.

We have taken away using a number line.

Crossed out the Super Heroes to see how many were left.

We used a Numicon 10 for a hotel with people in and threw a dice to take away those who had been going for breakfast and who was left having a lie in. Who went on the coach trip and how many were left. Who went to the pool and how many were left.

As an introduction we have revisited shape and properties through songs and rhymes as well as problems.

We ended the week inviting children to be the teachers. Which of the staffs answers are right and which are wrong? They marked our work!

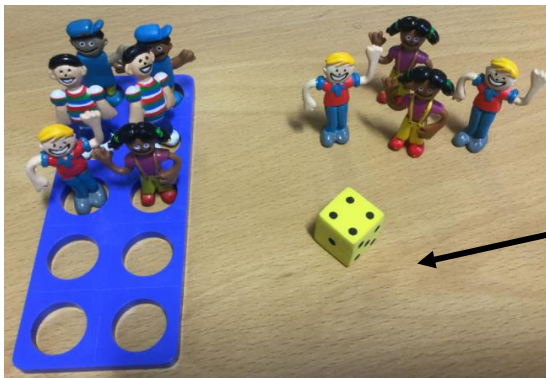
We have enjoyed a wonderful printing session delivered by the Laing Art Gallery.
