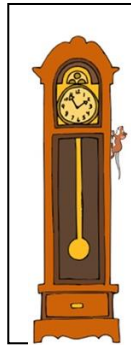
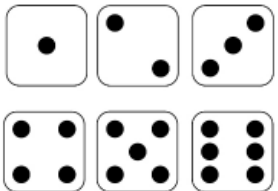


Bubble Solution - Can you make your own bubble solution following this recipe?

Tracks - Can you use masking tape to create a car track on the floor?

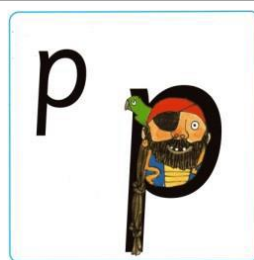


Knows that numbers identify how many objects are in a set -

Sound of the Week - Check out the Ruth Miskin parent video on YouTube - How to say the sounds. Help children to **hear and say p**. Talk about the sound it makes at the beginning of words like pirate, pizza, pencil and purse.

We use the picture to help us remember this sound and the formation rhyme to help us write it: down the pirate's plait and around his face. Try using your finger to write p in sand/flour/glitter whilst saying the formation rhyme.
