
This week has been Anti-Bullying week in school and we supported the campaign by wearing odd socks on Monday to celebrate our uniqueness!

Reminders:

We have enjoyed another fantastic week outdoors at the circus! There have been new activities to try such as stilt walking and show jumping. The children have really loved the different sports, perfecting their balancing skills and strengthening their gross motor skills.



As part of our Talk for Writing scheme in school we have been reading 'The Gingerbread Man'. We have loved listening to the story and joining in on the parts we know 'Run, run as fast as you can, you can't catch me I'm the Gingerbread man'. As a special treat for showing super friendship this week, we got to make our own Gingerbread biscuits. The different spices smelt amazing and we had lots of fun making and rolling the dough.

In math, we have continued to look at number problems and sharing strategies to resolve them. We have also been busy making our own number lines 0-10 using numicon and used them to find 1 more and 1 less than a given number within 10.
