At the start of this week we read the story 'The Jolly Postman'. The children loved guessing which traditional tales each letter related to and it gave us the opportunity to think about how letters are delivered and the long journey they sometimes need to go on. To link with this story we set up a role-play post office. The children loved posting their letters and postcards and pretending to be the postman delivering all the letters and parcels. There were lots of opportunities for mark-making and use of mathematical language throughout the children's play. In particular the children impressed us with their interest in writing names and addresses on their envelopes. This took many different forms and the children are all supported at their own level. We found out about the journey a letter goes on from the time it is put in the post-box to when it arrives at its destination.
