

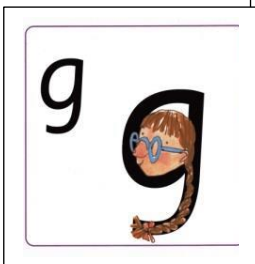


Southridge First School Nursery Newsletter 31st January 2020

To help the children develop an understanding of other cultures, this week we found out all about Chinese New Year. The children heard about how people prepare for Chinese New Year and how it is celebrated. We looked at some Chinese writing and numbers.

In phonics we have been learning about the phoneme /g/ and the sound it makes in words like garden, goat, girl and glue. It is a short, bouncy sound. We use the picture to help us remember this sound and the formation rhyme to help us write it: round her face, down her hair and give her a curl. Our sound next week is /q/.
