Empowering Your Child.

Parents often ask us what they can do at home to support their child's learning and they are sometimes surprised at our response. The best thing you can do to support your child at this stage in the Nursery year is to promote independence by encouraging them to put on their own socks, shoes and coats. Zips and buttons are really tricky but with lots of practise children are extremely proud when they eventually conquer these skills. In Nursery we gently encourage children to have a try themselves first. We then show them how and help with whatever it is they need. It is wonderful to see how empowering these skills are to children and we love to celebrate them!
