Southridge First School - Governing Body's Annual Statement 2019 - 20

The Issues faced and addressed by the Governing Body over the last year were:

- Supporting the Headteacher and staff in the response to Coronavirus pandemic – closure of school to pupils, safe environment for children of critical works (March – June), wider opening on 1st June to priority year groups
- Monitoring of Home Learning via school website
- Monitoring of attainment and progress to ensure high standards maintained
- Reviewing the Quality of Education – Curriculum, in the light of the new Education Inspection Framework
- Safeguarding Policies all updated in line with Keeping Children Safe in Education
- Monitoring Sports Premium Funding and Pupil Premium Funding
- Ensuring all Health and Safety standards are met

The impact of the Governing Body on the school was:

- Standards have been maintained in all key phases up until the point of school closure on March 20th
- School remained open to critical workers
- Home Learning ensured consistent learning for children – see feedback from parents
- Over 90% of priority year groups (Reception and Year 1) return to school for wider opening from 1st June – high levels of parent confidence.
- 95% of year 4 pupils (transition year for middle school) returned from 1st June
- In the last week of the summer term 98% of Year 3 and 4 pupils returned to school for 2 transition days with their new classteacher to support transition and mental health / wellbeing of this group of children who had been at home learning since March.
- The Headteacher is supported by a strong Leadership Team
- Full awareness of safeguarding
